Quick Start Guide

This guide is intended to guide you through the basic functions of this navigation system. For details, please refer to Operation Manual.

Basic Hardware buttons



1) NO button

Press briefly to start the voice operation.

Press and hold to mute the AV source.

② **VOL** (+/–) button

Press to adjust the AV (Audio and Video) source volume.

③ **HOME** button

Press to display the "Top Menu" screen.


(4) MODE button

Press to switch between the map screen and the AV operation screen.


- (5) TRK (**◄**/**▶**) button
- ⑥ ▲ button

Press to display the control panel of the LCD panel.

Display the menu screen



Basic items on the map




- 1) Name of the street to be used (or next guidance
- (2) Current time
- (3) Estimated time of arrival
- (4) Current route
- (5) Current position

- 6 Street name that your vehicle is traveling along
- (7) Eco-Meter
- (8) Zoom in/Zoom out
- (9) Next direction of travel

Destination Menu

Touch Destination on the "Top Menu" screen.



- (1) Searches for location by address
- (2) Calculates the route home
- 3 Searches for a place from stores, restaurants, and other businesses in the points of interest database
- (4) Searches for POIs by using the data on external storage devices (SD card)
- (5) Selects your stored location

- (6) Returns to the previous screen
- Selects a previously routed destination
- (8) Searches for a location by coordinates
- (9) Cancels your current route
- 10 Displays the current route information
- (1) Displays information on MSN® Direct

Searching for your destination by address

Display the "Destination Menu" screen and touch Address.



2 Input the information that vou want to set as the destination.



Touch one of the options. After narrowing down your destination, the Location confirmation screen will appear.

3 Touch OK.



After searching for the destination, the Route confirmation screen appears.

4 Touch OK.





The navigation system gives you route guidance both visually and by voice.

Setting the volume of the route guidance

- 1 Touch the keys in the following order in the "Top Menu" screen. Settings → System Settings → Volume
- 2 Touch + or to change the volume of the route guidance.



Inserting and ejecting an SD card

Inserting an SD card

- 1 Press ≜ button. The "Monitor Setup" screen appears.
- 2 Touch SD Insert on the screen.
- 3 Insert an SD memory card into the SD card slot.



4 Press ≜ button.

Ejecting an SD card


- Press ≜ button. The "Monitor Setup" screen appears.
- 2 Touch Eject SD on the screen.
- 3 Press the middle of the SD memory card gently until it clicks.
- 4 Pull the SD memory card out straight.



5 Press ≜ button

Using the radio (FM)

Scroll the screen by dragging an AV source icon up or down, and tap FM on the AV operation screen.



Displays the current preset frequency list

 Scans until a broadcast strong enough for good reception is found

Playing your Apple iPod

You can control an iPod by connecting the USB interface cable for iPod (CD-IU50V) (sold separately) to the navigation system.


1 Connect your iPod.



The source changes and then playback will start.

2 Tap or drag the key that you want to operate.





- Displays the artist name list, album title list or song title list
- ② Displays the category list
- 3 Displays the genre list
- ④ Selects the song to play by scrolling and dragging the key up or down. To play the song, tap it
- (5) Switches the list screen between music and video
- (6) Selects a song by scrolling and dragging the character tab up or down. Tap the tab of the character for the song title that you want to display
- Tarts playback by tapping an item to select

Pairing your phone

- 1 Activate the Bluetooth function on your phone.
- 2 Touch the keys in the following order in the "Top Menu" screen.
 Settings ➡ Bluetooth Settings
- 3 Touch Bluetooth On/Off to select On.



4 Touch Registration on the "Bluetooth Settings" screen.

The system tries to find and lists nearby devices.

5 Touch your phone on the list.



6 Enter the PIN code from your phone. (The default code is 1111.)

When the pairing is successful, the message will appear.

Transferring the phone book

- 1 Connect the cellular phone.
- 2 Touch Contacts Transfer on the "Phone Menu" screen.
- 3 Check that the following screen is displayed, and operate your cellular phone to transfer the phone book entries.



After transferring the data is finished, a message asking whether you want to transfer more data appears.

4 Touch No.



The transferred data is imported to the navigation system.
